

## SECTION 00020 INVITATION TO BID

The Town of Delmont, South Dakota, will receive sealed bids for their Wastewater System Improvements Project until **Wednesday, April 28, 2021 at 2:00 PM (local time)**. Bids can be delivered to the Finance Office at 105 West Main Street, Delmont, SD 57330, where the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above time.

The major elements associated with the construction of the Wastewater System Improvements are approximately:

### Bid Schedule A

- 4,120 Square yards of milling asphalt/blotter and gravel base course
- 4,120 square yards of remove and dispose of asphalt/blotter surface
- 52 sanitary sewer manholes, with approximately 128 VF of additional depth
- 16,400 feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer main
- 16,400 feet of TV inspect 8-inch sanitary sewer
- 2,400 feet of clean, inspect, and pre-rehabilitation TV of sewer
- 2,400 feet of 8" cured-in-place pipe liner
- 19 sewer main connections
- 127 sewer service connections
- 220 feet of 12-inch CMP culvert
- 60 feet of 18-inch CMP culvert
- 4,900 cubic yards of general street excavation
- 360 cubic yards of general ditch excavation
- 5,100 tons of gravel surfacing or base course
- 1,600 tons of asphalt surfacing
- 125 square yards of concrete sidewalks, approaches, or valley gutters
- 6,500 square yards of salvage and replace topsoil
- 26,500 square yards of seeding disturbed areas
- Traffic control and detours

### Bid Schedule B: Lift Station Improvements

- Replace pumps
- Replace controls
- Replace air release valves
- Coat exposed steel surfaces
- Electrical wiring and equipment improvements

### Bid Schedule C: Wastewater Treatment Pond Improvements

- Remove and dispose existing interpond piping
- Remove and dispose existing pond manhole
- Line existing inlet manhole
- Interpond piping with siphon breaker, and inlet and outlet structures
- 2100 cubic yards of sludge removal and land application
- Pond depth indicators
- 2,800 tons of class "A" riprap with 1,200 tons furnished by Town
- 355 cubic yards of general dike excavation
- 975 cubic yards of borrowed fill placement
- 1,490 feet of dike shaping
- 2,400 feet of fencing
- 3,400 square yards of seeding disturbed areas

The approximate quantities mentioned above are subject to increase or decrease. It will be agreed by bidders that all quantities of work will be performed in accordance with the provisions of the plans and specifications and at the unit price bid. Bidders agree to furnish all labor, material, and equipment necessary to complete all the work as shown in the plans and specifications.

The complete set of Contract Documents, including drawings and specifications, is on file with the Finance Officer, Delmont, South Dakota and/or at the office of Schmucker, Paul, Nohr and Associates, 2100 North Sanborn Blvd, Mitchell, South Dakota 57301. A paper copy of the contract documents and plans can be ordered with a non-refundable payment of \$40 plus applicable sales taxes. The contract documents and plans will also be made available at the SPN web site [www.spn-assoc.com](http://www.spn-assoc.com) with a non-refundable payment of \$20. Upon request, one copy of the contract documents and plans will be furnished at no charge as required by SDCL 5-18B-1 to each contractor who is a South Dakota resident and who intends to bid the project.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bank draft payable to the order of the Town of Delmont, South Dakota, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid. A bid bond in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total bid will be accepted in lieu of a certified check or bank draft. Surety for bid bond must be authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota.

Pursuant to State Law, a copy of the bidder's sales and use tax license and a copy of the bidder's excise tax license as issued by the State of South Dakota must accompany the bid. In lieu of a copy of the license, the bidder shall submit appropriate evidence that the bidder and all affiliates have the appropriate licenses.

Bidders are advised that any contracts awarded on this project will be partially funded by the South Dakota State Revolving Fund (SRF) program, the United States Department of Agriculture - Rural Development and the Community Development Block Grant program. All requirements of the funding agencies for construction projects shall be met by all contractors and/or subcontractors performing work on this project. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Invitation for Bids or any resulting contract. This procurement will be subject to EPA regulations contained in 40 CFR 35.936, 35.938 and 35.939. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Title 40 CFR 33, Title 40 CFR 35 and Executive Order 12138. The goal for Minority-Owned Business Enterprise (MBE) on this project is one percent (1%) and the goal for Woman-Owned Business Enterprise (WBE) on this project is four percent (4%). The other requirements for bidders and contractors under this regulation which concerns utilization of disadvantaged/minority business enterprises are explained in Part I of these Contract Documents.

Compliance with the American Iron and Steel provision of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 is required. A certification form is included with the bidding documents and must be included with the bid. Note that waivers or exemptions from the Buy American provision which refer to International Trade Agreements do not comply with the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 for SRF programs. Claims from suppliers will not be accepted which indicate that the American Iron and Steel provision does not apply to certain products based on the International Trade Agreement exemptions of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014.

Bidders are also reminded that not less than the minimum wages as determined by the Davis-Bacon Act and set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project and that the contractor and/or subcontractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or natural origin.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order Nos. 11246, the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and the "Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications" as amended, 11518 (Small Business Concerns), and 11625 (MBE) as amended. The requirements for bidders and contractors under these orders are explained in the Contract Documents.

NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT FOR AFFIRMATIVE  
ACTION TO ENSURE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT  
OPPORTUNITY (EXECUTIVE ORDER 11246)

In addition to all of the above-listed Federal requirements for work on this project, compliance with the contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, Executive Order 11375, Copeland Act, the Clean Air Act, and Water Pollution Control Act and subsequent amendments to all of the above will be required of contractors and/or subcontractors performing work on this project.

The low responsive bidder must assure compliance with the requirements of Public Law 115-232, Section 889, Prohibition on Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment.

The successful bidder—including any contractors on the project, must be registered in SAM (System for Award Management).

Bids may be held by the Town Board of Delmont, South Dakota, for a period of not more than thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids, investigating the qualifications of the bidders and completing financial arrangements prior to awarding the Work. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding and make awards to the Owner's best interest.
