

**CITY OF PHILIP, SOUTH DAKOTA
INVITATION TO BID
SOUTHWEST PHILIP IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
UTILITY & STREET IMPROVEMENTS**

The City Council of Philip, South Dakota, will receive sealed bids for their Southwest Philip Wastewater and Street Improvements Project until **11:00 AM** (local time), **Thursday, May 24, 2018**, at the City of Philip Finance, located on the 4th floor of the Haakon County Courthouse at 140 South Howard Avenue in Philip, South Dakota. Sealed bids may be sent to the City Administrator, City of Philip at PO Box 408, Philip, South Dakota 57567. Received sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above place and time.

Bids are invited upon the items and approximate quantities of work as follows:

Bid Schedule A

Approximately 1,400 feet of curb and gutter removal, 158 square yards of driveway removal, 660 square yards of sidewalk removal, 1,833 cubic yards of unclassified excavation, 25 cubic yards of Contractor-furnished topsoil placement, 2,266 tons of gravel base course, 532 tons of salvaging and placing milled asphalt, 420 tons of asphalt surfacing, 2,150 square yards of 8" non-reinforced concrete surfacing, 32 square yards of 6" concrete approach, 185 square yards of 8" concrete approach, 24 square yards of 6" concrete fillet section, 58 square yards of 8" concrete fillet section, 430 feet of 15" RCP storm sewer, 480 feet of pavement striping, 1,318 feet of curb and gutter, 78 square yards of 8" valley gutter, 5,180 square feet of 4" concrete sidewalk, 4 each 2'x 3' storm inlets, 2,428 feet of 4" underdrain, miscellaneous traffic control and erosion control, and all related appurtenances to the aforementioned work.

Bid Schedule B

Approximately 1,200 feet of 4" sanitary service pipe, 2,117 feet of 8" sewer main, 390 feet of 10" sewer main, 370 feet of 12" sewer main, 45 each sewer wyes of various sizes, 2,877 feet of sewer video inspection, miscellaneous sewer connections, post installation sewer video inspection, and all related appurtenances to the aforementioned work.

Bid Schedule C

Approximately 3,558 feet of curb and gutter removal, 429 square yards of driveway pavement removal, 224 square yards of valley gutter removal, 803 square yards of sidewalk removal, 5,531 cubic yards of unclassified excavation, 115 cubic yards of placing Contractor-furnished topsoil, 5,065 tons of base course, 1,278 tons of salvaging and placing milled asphalt, 1,958 tons of asphalt surfacing, 725 square yards of 6" concrete approach, 192 square yards of 8" concrete approach, 105 square yards of 6" concrete fillet section, 37 square yards of concrete valley gutter, 4,013 feet of curb and gutter, 7,280 square feet of 4" concrete sidewalk, miscellaneous erosion control, and all related appurtenances to the aforementioned work.

Bid Schedule D – Sunshine Drive Overlay

Approximately 304 feet of curb and gutter removal, 1,000 square yards of asphalt removal, 390 cubic yards of unclassified excavation, 817 square yards of asphalt milling, 691 tons of base course, 403 tons of asphalt concrete composite, 16 square yards of 6" concrete fillet section, 60 square yards of concrete driveway pavement, 284 feet of curb and gutter, 843 square yards of geotextile fabric separator, miscellaneous traffic and erosion control, and all related appurtenances to the aforementioned work.

The approximate quantities mentioned above are subject to increase or decrease. It will be agreed by bidders that all quantities of work will be performed in accordance with the provisions of the plans and specifications and at the unit price bid. Bidders agree to furnish all labor,

material, and equipment necessary to complete all the work as shown in the plans and specifications.

The complete set of Contract Documents, including drawings and specifications, is on file with the Finance Officer, City Hall, Philip, South Dakota 57567, and/or at the office of Schmucker, Paul, Nohr and Associates, 2100 North Sanborn Blvd, Mitchell, South Dakota 57301. A paper copy of the contract documents and plans can be ordered with a non-refundable payment of \$ 50 plus applicable taxes. The contract documents and plans will also be made available at the SPN web site www.spn-assoc.com with a non-refundable payment of \$20. Upon request, one copy of the contract documents and plans will be furnished at no charge as required by SDCL 5-18B-1 to each Contractor who is a South Dakota resident and who intends to bid the project.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bank draft payable to the order of the City of Philip, South Dakota, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid. A bid bond in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total bid will be accepted in lieu of a certified check or bank draft. Surety for bid bond must be authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota.

Pursuant to State Law, a copy of the bidder's sales and use tax license and a copy of the bidder's excise tax license as issued by the State of South Dakota must accompany the bid. In lieu of a copy of the license, the bidder shall submit appropriate evidence that the bidder and all affiliates have the appropriate licenses.

Bidders are advised that any contracts awarded for this project will be partially funded by the South Dakota State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan, the South Dakota Department of Transportation Community Access Road Grant, Governor's Office of Economic Development CDBG (Community Development Block Grant), and the City of Philip. All requirements for construction projects of the above-listed agencies will be required of all contractors and/or subcontractors performing work on this project. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Invitation to Bid or any resulting contract. This procurement will be subject to EPA regulations contained in 40 CFR 35.936, 35.938 and 35.939.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Title 40 CFR 33 and Executive Order 12138. The goal for Minority-Owned Business Enterprise (MBE) on this project is four percent (4%) and the goal for Woman-Owned Business Enterprise (WBE) on this project is two percent (2%). The goals and other requirements for bidders and contractors under this regulation which concerns utilization of disadvantaged/minority business enterprises are explained in the Contract Documents.

The successful bidder, including any contractors and their subcontractors on the project, must be registered in SAM (System for Award Management).

NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT FOR AFFIRMATIVE
ACTION TO ENSURE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT
OPPORTUNITY (EXECUTIVE ORDER 11246)

Compliance with the American Iron and Steel provision of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 is required. A certification form is included with the bidding documents and must be included with the bid. Note that waivers or exemptions from the Buy American provision which refer to International Trade Agreements do not comply with the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 for SRF programs. Claims from suppliers will not be accepted which indicate that the American Iron and Steel provision does not apply to certain products based on the International Trade Agreement exemptions of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Title 40 CFR 35.936-7 Title 40 CFR 33 and Executive Order 12138. The goals and other requirements for bidders and contractors under this

regulation which concerns utilization of disadvantaged/minority business enterprises are explained in Part I of these Contract Documents.

The Bidder's attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and the "Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications". The requirements for bidders and Contractors under this order are explained in Part I of these Contract Documents.


Bidders are also reminded that not less than the minimum wages as determined by the Davis-Bacon Act and set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project and that the contractor and/or subcontractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or natural origin.

In addition to all of the above-listed Federal requirements for work on this project, compliance with the contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, Executive Order 11375, Copeland Act, the Clean Air Act, and Water Pollution Control Act and subsequent amendments to all of the above will be required of contractors and/or subcontractors performing work on this project.


