MAIN AVENUE STREET IMPROVEMENTS, MAIN AVENUE STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS AND WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Main Avenue Street Improvements, Main Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements and Wastewater Collection System Improvements** will be received by the **City of Presho**, at the **Finance Office**, located at PO Box 100, 316 N Main Avenue, Presho, SD 57568, until **3:00 pm** Central Time on February 21, 2019, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project consists of:

Main Avenue Street Improvements:

Approximately 8,700 tons of salvaging asphalt and gravel base course, 340 square yards of concrete approach pavement, 180 square yards of concrete fillets, 2,100 feet of concrete curb and gutter, 150 square yards of concrete valley gutter, 21,000 square feet of concrete sidewalk, miscellaneous water main improvements, traffic control, erosion control and all related appurtenances to the aforementioned work.

Alternate bids for street surfacing on Main Avenue (approximately 2,550 tons of asphalt concrete; approximately 10,000 square yards of 8" nonreinforced concrete pavement)

Main Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements:

Approximately 3,000 feet of RCP storm sewer, 100 feet of boring and jacking 36" RCP, 25 each of storm sewer structures including manholes and inlets, 11 each area drains and all related appurtenances to the aforementioned work.

Wastewater Collection System Improvements:

Approximately 19,500 feet of PVC sanitary sewer main of various sizes, 8,400 feet of 4" PVC sanitary sewer service pipe, 160 feet of sewer pipe boring, 60 each sanitary manholes, 19,500 feet of post installation sanitary sewer video inspection, 12,250 tons of salvaging asphalt and gravel base course, 4,200 tons of asphalt surfacing, 1,510 feet of concrete curb and gutter, 1,000 square yards of concrete pavement and driveway approach pavement, 72 square yards of concrete valley gutter, 60 square yards of concrete fillets, miscellaneous storm sewer improvements, traffic control, erosion control and all related appurtenances to the aforementioned work.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Monday through Friday between the hours of **8:00 am to 5:00 pm** and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at the City of Presho, on Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Bidding Documents may be viewed and ordered online upon a one-time payment of \$20.00 by registering with the Issuing Office at <http://www.spn-assoc.com>. Following registration, complete sets of Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the Issuing Office's website as portable document format (PDF) files. The 11"x17" paper drawings and Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office upon payment to Schmucker, Paul, Nohr & Associates in the amount of \$50.00 for shipping and handling. Cost of Bidding Documents and shipping is non-refundable. **Additionally, upon request, in accordance with South Dakota Codified Law 5-18B-1, one copy of Plans and Specifications shall be furnished, without charge, to each Contractor resident in South Dakota who intends, in good faith, to bid upon the project.** The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of the Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Pursuant to State Law, a copy of the bidder's sales and use tax license and a copy of the bidder's excise tax license as issued by the State of South Dakota must accompany the bid. In lieu of a copy of the license, the bidder shall submit appropriate evidence that the bidder and all affiliates have the appropriate licenses.

Bidders are advised that any contracts awarded for this project will be partially funded by the South Dakota State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan, the South Dakota Department of Transportation Community Access Road Grant, Governor's Office of Economic Development CDBG (Community Development Block Grant), and the City of Presho. All requirements for construction projects of the above-listed agencies will be required of all contractors and/or subcontractors performing work on this project. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Advertisement for Bids or any resulting contract. This procurement will be subject to EPA regulations contained in 40 CFR 35.936, 35.938 and 35.939.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Title 40 CFR 33 and Executive Order 12138. The goal for Minority-Owned Business Enterprise (MBE) on this project is one percent (1%) and the goal for Woman-Owned Business Enterprise (WBE) on this project is four percent (4%). The goals and other requirements for bidders and contractors under this regulation which concerns utilization of disadvantaged/minority business enterprises are explained in the Contract Documents.

The successful bidder, including any contractors and their subcontractors on the project, must be registered in SAM (System for Award Management).

NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT FOR AFFIRMATIVE
ACTION TO ENSURE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT
OPPORTUNITY (EXECUTIVE ORDER 11246)

Compliance with the American Iron and Steel provision of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 is required. A certification form is included with the bidding documents and must be included with the bid. Note that waivers or exemptions from the Buy American provision which refer to International Trade Agreements do not comply with the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 for SRF programs. Claims from suppliers will not be accepted which indicate that the American Iron and Steel provision does not apply to certain products based on the International Trade Agreement exemptions of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Title 40 CFR 35.936-7, Title 40 CFR 33 and Executive Order 12138. The goals and other requirements for bidders and contractors under this regulation which concern utilization of disadvantaged/minority business enterprises are explained in Part I of these Contract Documents.

The Bidder's attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and the "Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications". The requirements for bidders and Contractors under this order are explained in Part I of these Contract Documents.

Bidders are also reminded that not less than the minimum wages as determined by the Davis-Bacon Act and set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project and that the contractor and/or subcontractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or natural origin.

In addition to all of the above-listed Federal requirements for work on this project, compliance with the contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, Executive Order 11375, Copeland Act, the Clean Air Act, and Water Pollution Control Act and subsequent amendments to all of the above will be required of contractors and/or subcontractors performing work on this project.

Bids may be held by the City Council of Presho, South Dakota, for a period of not more than thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids, investigating the qualifications of the bidders and completing financial arrangements prior to awarding the Work.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding and make awards to the Owner's best interest.
